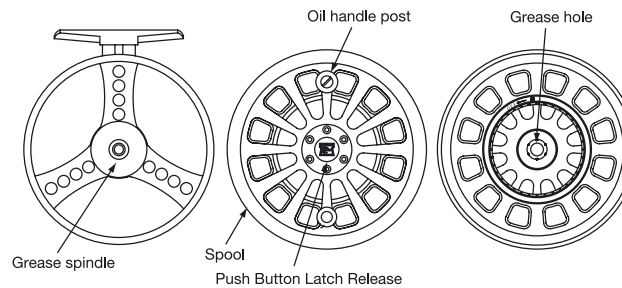

Care and maintenance

The same method of cleaning is valid for all reels in the freshwater Demon Reel range.

1. Remove line and backing.
2. Remove the spool.
3. Flush away dirt by placing the spool and frame under a stream of warm water.
4. Dry carefully with a lint free cloth.
5. Lubricate with a good quality oil at the points illustrated on the diagrams.
6. Always ensure the spindle head is adequately greased.
7. Always turn the drag to the minimum setting to avoid compression of the pad & springs.
8. Always ensure the reel and line are dry before storing in the case or pouch.

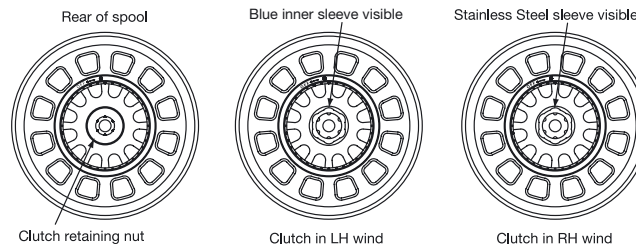


Changing your reel from left to right hand wind

All Demon reels are designed to work in right or left hand wind. When you receive your reel, it will be set for left hand wind.

To convert your reel to right hand wind:

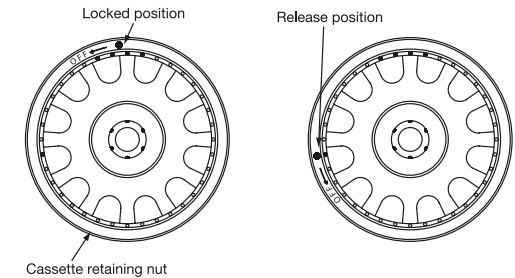
1. Remove the spool out of the frame by depressing the push button latch release and lifting the spool out of the frame.
2. Turn the spool over so that the clutch retaining nut is visible by rotating the drum 180 degrees.
3. Using your thumb and forefinger, remove the retaining nut by turning anti-clockwise.
4. The one way clutch is now visible, remove this from the drum by rotating 180 degrees. Place your palm underneath the clutch as you tilt the spool in order to catch the clutch.
5. Turn the clutch holder through 180° and replace it back in the spool housing. The end of the clutch unit with the stainless steel showing should now be upright and visible.
6. Using your thumb & forefinger, replace the retaining nut by turning clockwise.
7. Replace the spool into the frame - your reel should now be right hand wind.



Changing your cassette spool

All Demon reels are supplied with 3 interchangeable cassette spools, to change between cassettes, follow the steps below.

1. Remove the spool out of the frame by depressing the push button latch release and lifting the spool out of the frame.
2. Turn the spool over so that the cassette retaining nut is visible.
3. Using your thumb and forefinger, move the retaining nut from the locked position which is the four red spotted area into the single red spot release point by turning anti-clockwise.
4. The cassette is now easily removed from the spool.
5. Fit the desired cassette onto the spool, ensuring the raised keys on the front of the cassette are fully aligned with the machined cut-out in the spool.
6. using your thumb and forefinger, move the retaining nut from the released single dot position into the locked four spotted area, anywhere in this area will fully lock the cassette onto the spool.



Demon disc drag

The disc drag mechanism can be adjusted by simply turning the regulator button on the face of the frame, clockwise to increase the drag, anti-clockwise to decrease the drag. When the reel is not in use, the drag should be turned to the minimum setting.
